

VII International Meeting of Economics (IME-7)

Travel Grant Application

The Organising Committee of the IME-7, jointly with the Young Scientist Initiative (YSI) announces the availability of travel grants to help cover the costs of participation in the VII International Meeting of Economics 6th- 8th September 2023 in Quito, Ecuador.

A total of eleven travel grants sponsored by YSI will be awarded to applicants. A preference will be given to graduate students and early career-scholars travelling from other countries of Latin America and from other cities than Quito in Ecuador.

- 8 x US\$100 for scholars coming from other cities in Ecuador and

- 3 x US\$350 coming from other Latin American countries.

YSI would ask recipients of their award to [subscribe](#) to the YSI as a member.

To apply for a IME-7 travel grant, the following documents should be submitted to encuentroeconomia@epn.edu.ec as a single PDF-document by July 24th, 2023:

- completed application form (see below).
- a motivation letter (one page maximum length) describing why you would like to participate in the IME-7.
- a curriculum vitae (two pages maximum length), including a short list of publications (maximum total of 10 publications).
- an abstract of your paper that you will present at the IME-7.

Only completed applications will be accepted.

All applicants will be notified of the outcome of the selection procedure by July 28th, 2023.

Travel grant application deadline: July 24th, 2023.
